GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

GOAL IV. Analysis, Evaluation, and Application: Aesthetic Criticism

CORE OBJECTIVE A: Students will evaluate selected musical compositions using established criteria.

Enabling Objectives:

- 1. Students will develop evaluative criteria based on the elements of music.
- 2. Students will demonstrate independence in identifying and making judgments concerning harmony, timbre, texture, and form.
- 3. Students will use developed criteria to evaluate the artistic quality of music compositions.
- 4. Students will evaluate recorded and live performances of individual voices and choral ensembles, using established criteria to make qualitative judgments.
- 5. Students will evaluate a given musical work in terms of its aesthetic qualities and will explain the musical means the composer has used to evoke emotions and feelings.
- 6. Students will evaluate a performance, composition, arrangement, or improvisation by comparing it to similar or exemplary models.

CORE OBJECTIVE B. Students will evaluate their own performances and performances of others using established criteria.

Enabling Objectives:

- 1. Students will develop, assess, and revise standards to evaluate their own individual vocal performance.
- 2. Students will critique the performances of others within the ensemble setting using predetermined criteria.

3. Students will critique their own vocal performance and its relationship to the full ensemble sound.
