

TIPS for Reading Informational Texts

BEFORE Reading Strategies

- Think about what you already know on this topic.
- Preview the text before reading, looking at illustrations, charts, headings, and bold words.
- Think of questions about the topic.
- Predict topic words you think will appear in this passage.

DURING Reading Strategies

- Consciously think about what might be important.
- Use the pictures.
- Look at charts, maps, and illustrations.
- When you find challenging words, use what you know about reading -
 - Use the pictures.
 - Think about what makes sense.
 - Look at the beginning and ending sounds.
 - Chunk the word.
- Make Connections.
- When you don't understand, stop and reread.



AFTER Reading Strategies

- D Think about what you have read -
 - What was most important?
 - Were there any confusing areas you should reread?
 - Are there any parts of the text you should mark as being most important?
