#### Other discussion

- Plan AAC\_H was updated per plan originator's request. Plans were posted online.

- One committee member asked how plans can be folded together. Plans can be built based on a specific starting point (existing conditions, staff plan, or another plan), then additional changes are added.

- Plans to use undercrowded schools in the west for special programs can be considered. This is already being done at Triadelphia Ridge ES and Dayton Oaks ES. The schools must be centrally located for transportation from around the county.

- The Feasibility Study show assessments for the 2013 Staff plan for elementary schools (page 34) and the Supplement includes an assessment for the cumulative staff plan (page 6-9).

- Staff uses a polygon distance measure in the assessment, and the Pupil Transportation reviews plans individually as needed for further cost analysis.

- The creation of walk areas was discussed. Further information is to be provided.

- The AAC can develop additional alternative plans for review.

# Group Work

Work on redistricting plan(s) as one group. The group decided to start with plan AAC\_J (reports were posted online before the meeting) and make adjustments. The new plan was named AAC\_L. See reports posted online for additional plan details.

Staff will run an assessment on the AAC\_L plan. The AAC wants to review the assessment of plan AAC\_L and consider the middle school redistricting for changes in low feeds created by the elementary school plan. The AAC\_L plan was created from the 2013 ES staff plan, and the AAC looks to adjust the 2014 MS staff plan, rather than start from the existing conditions. The AAC can compare the low existing low feeds with those created by the staff plan and by the AAC\_L plan.
