Procedures for review of records for newly enrolled students with a disability:

- School attempts to get all student records within 30-60 days of entering the Howard County Public School System
 School IEP team reviews student records to determine if there is documentation to indicate that the student meets
- the HCPSS eligibility criteria for the specified disability or if additional assessments are needed
- Completed form is stored in the student folder in section "Assessments and Evaluations."

<u>Directions</u>: Use the worksheet below to review the student's record. This review will help you to determine if there is documentation to indicate that the student meets the HCPSS eligibility criteria for the specified disability or if additional assessments are needed. Evidence of all five elements listed below must be included in the student's records.

- Instructional or behavioral interventions were attempted in an effort to assist the student prior to referral to the IEP for evaluation. If the student is identified as ED, is there a FBA and a BIP?

- □ Medical issues, if any, were identified through a parent questionnaire, IEP minutes, or written reports and were addressed and considered in the IEP process.
- □ There is documentation that classroom performance and appropriateness of instruction were considered in the decision-making process. (Note: If the student is preschool age, this information may not be available.)
- □ Assessments were appropriate for the suspected/identified disability
- □ Consideration was given to environmental and psychosocial stressors (e.g. transiency, linguistic differences, attendance, family stressors) that might have impacted the student.
