Lisbon Elementary School is the most western school in Howard County. This rural area is rich in history, and there is growing diversity among the student body. Lisbon's Mission Statement was re-framed last year as part of the School Improvement process: *to nurture a culture of pride that supports life-long learning and inspires students, staff and families to do their best.* With our priority on students and their learning, staff and parents team together to support children in reaching their goals and dreams. Lisbon continues to shine as a result of both our recent renovation and the student growth in academic progress.

Our School Improvement Plan includes reading, math, and climate goals, with a focus on the writing framework and mathematical processes from the initial implementation of the Common Core, plus STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) activities woven into the Gifted and Talented classes, and grade-level curriculum. Members from our gifted and talented, reading, and special education teams serve as resources to meet a variety of individual learner needs. In addition to our academic focus, we emphasize the importance of a positive learning culture as embedded in Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS), referred to in student friendly language as Respect, Organized, Always Safe, and Responsible, an initiative that started in 2006 and continues to recognize students for their individual positive behavior as well as provide interventions to students who need additional support.

The school's PTA is extremely supportive of our school mission and goals. There are many opportunities for parents to join committees or volunteer with classroom and family fun activities. Our PTA plans fun-filled events such as Ice Cream Social, Fall Festival, Monster Bash and snow tubing. They sponsor numerous and varied after-school programs such as sign language, Craft Pac, and art classes.

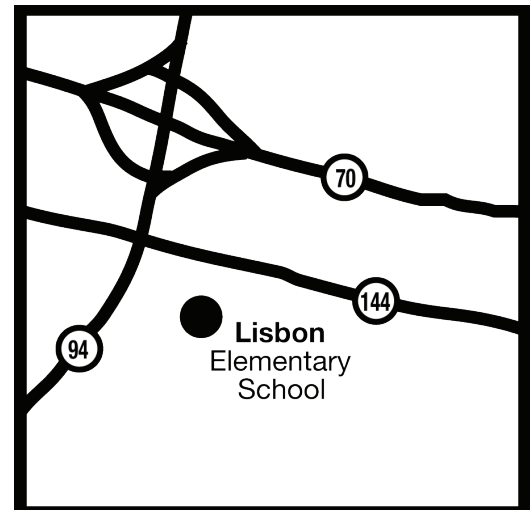

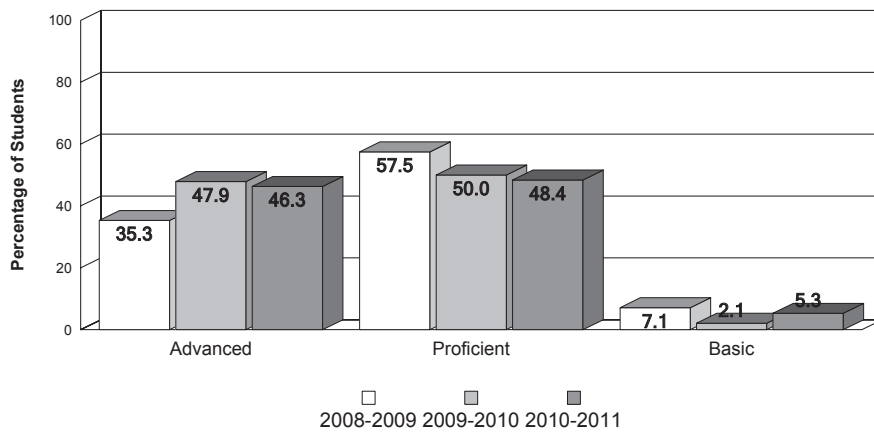

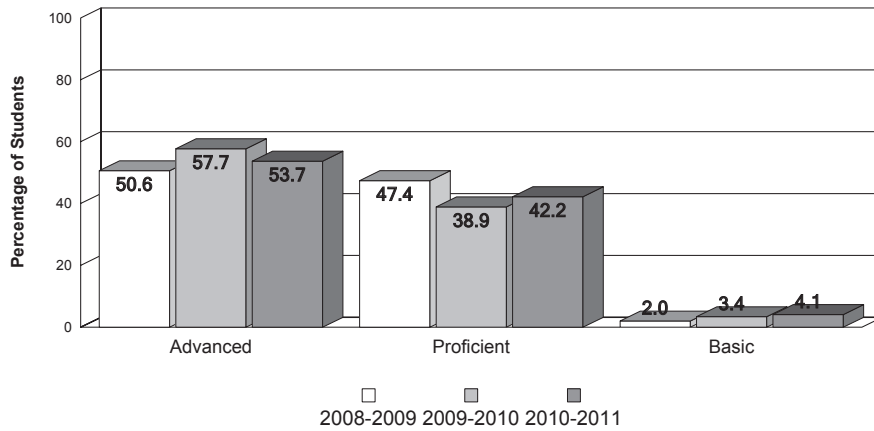
