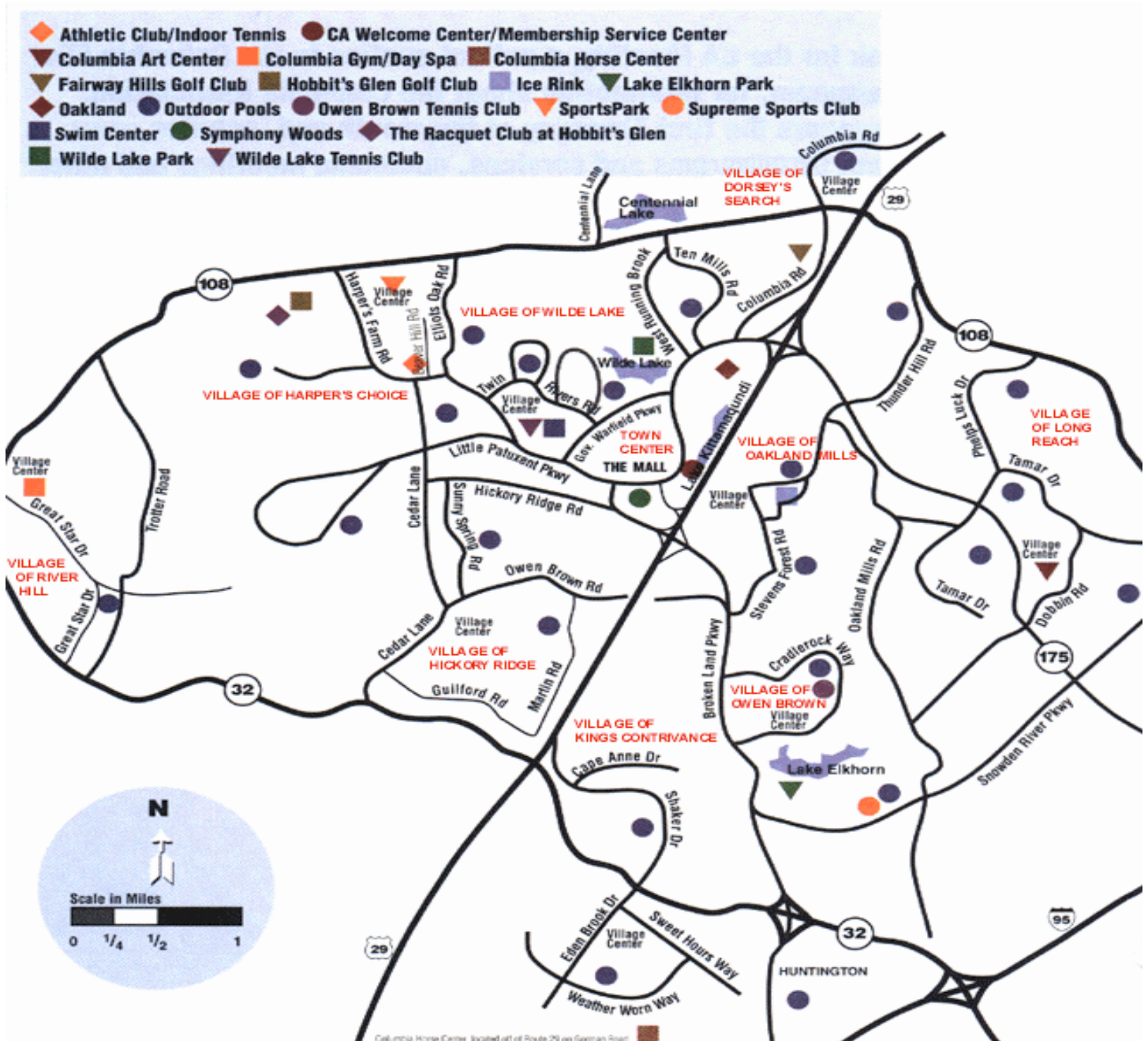

## Directions to Wilde Lake High School (5640 Trumpeter Way, Columbia, MD 21044)

From Baltimore - Take 695 to Rt. 70W to 29S to 175 west. Bear right on Governor Warfield Parkway. Turn right on Twin Rivers Road. Turn left on Trumpeter Way.

From Washington Take 95N to 32W to 29N to 175W. Bear right on Governor Warfield Parkway. Turn right on Twin Rivers Road. Turn left on Trumpeter Way.
