



Summer Social Skills Groups

Groups meet once per week for 75- minute sessions.

Groups meet for 6 weeks. Must commit to at least 4 of the weeks.

Children are grouped by age and social skill level.

Groups are limited to 6 children.

All groups are co-taught by 2 instructors, who include:

- ⇒ **Lori Jenner**, LCPC - Lori is a Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor and a Howard County School Counselor. She has specialization in working with children and families and has a post-masters certification in counseling at-risk youth.
- ⇒ **Randi Malamphy**, M.Ed. - Randi is a certified special educator with 28 years of experience who specializes in working with children of all ages and disabilities, and partnering with families.
- ⇒ **Taryn Silbert**, M.S., CCC- Taryn is a Speech-Language Pathologist who works in Howard County and owns a private practice, A-Z Communication, LLC.

Through interactive lessons, group activities, and games children will learn skills to improve social relationships with others. Groups will focus on enhancing social-interaction skills, communication and social thinking.
