As a community, Howard County takes great pride in our outstanding public school system -- and with good reason. For many years, our students have achieved the highest level of academic performance in the state, and our schools continue to rank among the finest in the nation.

These successes are especially noteworthy when considered in light of several factors which make maintaining high standards more challenging than ever before. A growing percentage of our children face daunting circumstances: more than one in ten Howard County students lives in poverty. Our students represent 80 nations and speak more than 70 different languages; many live in homes where little or no English is spoken.

Thanks to educational partnerships, Howard County public schools enjoy the support of hundreds of local businesses and community organizations. While partners take great satisfaction in helping students prepare for a better future, partnerships also offer other important benefits. The organization receives positive exposure among students, school staff, parents, and the community. By helping to improve our schools, partnerships enhance economic prosperity for the entire county, because the top notch reputation of Howard County schools is among our community's greatest assets.

Each partnership reflects the talents, assets, and interests of the partnering organization, but is typically in one of three categories, representing a donation of human resources, goods and services, or financial resources. Many partners encourage their employees to volunteer their time and expertise. These partnerships vary widely in scope, with examples ranging from mentoring independent research programs to tutoring students in basic skills, hosting field trips, speaking to classes about careers, or providing on-site work opportunities. Other partners donate goods and services, such as classroom supplies, books, scientific instruments, or other equipment; certificates, coupons, or other incentives; or meeting spaces.

Partners may also offer financial support through a donation to a school or to the Howard County Public Schools Educational Foundation. The Foundation was recently established to promote student achievement by encouraging community financial support for educational initiatives that are above and beyond the school system budget.

Non-profit Partnerships Fill Unique Role

The lives of Howard County students are enriched each day by countless acts of support and encouragement provided by representatives from non-profit organizations. These partners fill an invaluable role by helping students with unique needs which can not always be fully met during the regular school day. The following four organizations share a deep, longstanding commitment to Howard County students that exemplifies the special relationship between non-profits and the Howard County Public School System.

Alpha Achievers celebrate ten year anniversary

Just ten years ago, Vincent James coaxed eighteen somewhat reluctant African-American male students to attend the first meeting of the Alpha Achievers at Oakland Mills High School.

"Being known as an Alpha Achiever gives you positive recognition in school," says junior Julian Wood, president of the Alpha Achievers at Oakland Mills High. "Members have a leadership role, and are regarded as scholarly, well mannered, active, and creative."



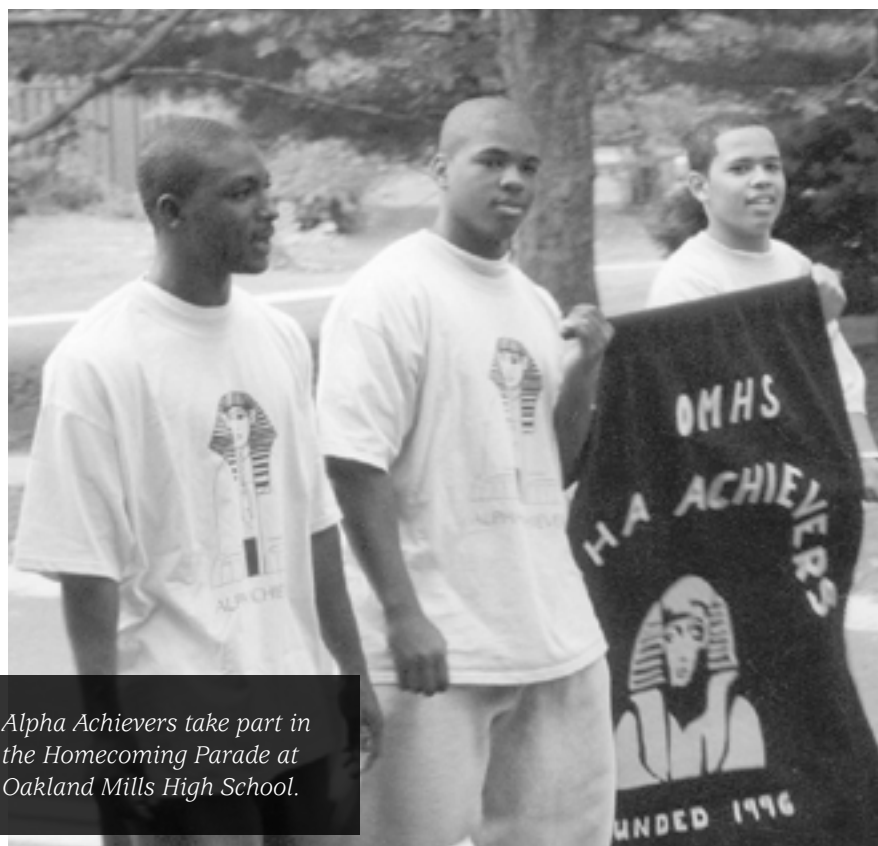
"At that time, it wasn't considered 'cool' to be smart," the gifted and talented resource teacher recalls. "I saw a need for a place where high achieving black students could get together, to support each other and find a positive sense of identity."

Today, membership in the Alpha Achievers is a highly prized distinction among the Oakland Mills student body, conveying similar status as the National Honor Society or student government. Membership ranks have swelled, with over 60 black, Hispanic, and other "young men of color" on the roster last year. Chapters have formed at several other Howard County high schools, including Wilde Lake, Long Reach, and Reservoir.

The group is affiliated with Alpha Phi Alpha, the nation's oldest intercollegiate fraternity established for African-Americans. A fraternity alumnus serves as advisor to each school chapter.

The combination of high academic standards - each Alpha Achiever must have at least a 3.0 grade point average - and prestige among classmates makes a powerful motivator for students to earn membership, then to keep grades high and fulfill other expectations required to remain in the group.

Every Alpha Achiever must participate in community service projects chosen by the members. For the last two years, the Achievers have mentored students at nearby middle and elementary schools who need extra help and attention due to lagging grades or behavioral problems. Field trips and other activities are scheduled throughout the year. The group supports itself, and raises funds to benefit special

causes, through a series of fundraisers; sales of calendars featuring a photo of an Achiever for each month have proved especially lucrative.

James, who has continued as chapter advisor at OMHS since starting the group ten years ago, has witnessed the difference that membership can make in the life of an Alpha Achiever. "Over eighty percent of past members have gone on to college and rewarding careers," he reports with pride. Today's Achievers enjoy more immediate benefits: "Being known as an Alpha Achiever gives you positive recognition in school," explains incoming president Julian Wood. "Members have a leadership role, and are regarded as scholarly, well mannered, active, and creative."

Helping Hands - helping students for over 20 years

Since 1987, the Helping Hands Educational and Leadership Foundation has enriched the lives of hundreds of Howard County students. Helping Hands offers Saturday academic enrichment sessions at several county schools. Through close alignment with school curriculum, skilled teaching, and enthusiastic support from school administrators and parents, Helping Hands improves academic skills and boosts students' confidence, helping them find pleasure and satisfaction from learning and school.

Helping Hands was launched in 1987 at Jeffers Hill Elementary, where founder Pat Dodson was a teacher at the time (she currently teaches English at Bonnie Branch Middle School). With

adds that fine teaching is at the heart of the program's success. "The teachers are so wonderful; so creative," she enthuses. "We could not ask for a better staff to work with these kids."

Grace Community Church

Members of Grace Community Church share their energy, talents, and hundreds of hours of time with HCPSS students throughout the year. Each year, a few lucky schools are the recipient of an "Extreme Makeover," bringing

more than 150 Grace volunteers for an intense day of raking, mulching, weeding, and overall beautification of the school's landscaping.

On "Science Explosion Saturday," Grace volunteers bring supplies and instructions to Swansfield Elementary and stay to help students create a science project. This program is targeted toward students who need extra assistance, enabling many to take part in the school science fair for the first time.

Dozens of Grace volunteers visit elementary and middle schools throughout the year to work one on one with students - helping with

homework, offering encouragement and guidance, and giving the kind of special individual attention that can make a big difference to a child who is struggling at school.

In recognition of its enormous support for Howard County Public Schools and students, Grace Community Church was honored this year with a Maryland Governor's Volunteer Service Award and was one of three recipients of the 2007 Howard County Board of Education Friends of Education Award.

Conexiones

Conexiones, Inc. has been promoting academic achievement among Hispanic students in Howard County since 2000. Conexiones founder Murray Simon established the organization in an effort to improve the academic performance of HCPSS Hispanic students. Conexiones sponsors after-school tutoring, field trips, scholarships, and an annual event to celebrate Hispanic students graduating from high school.

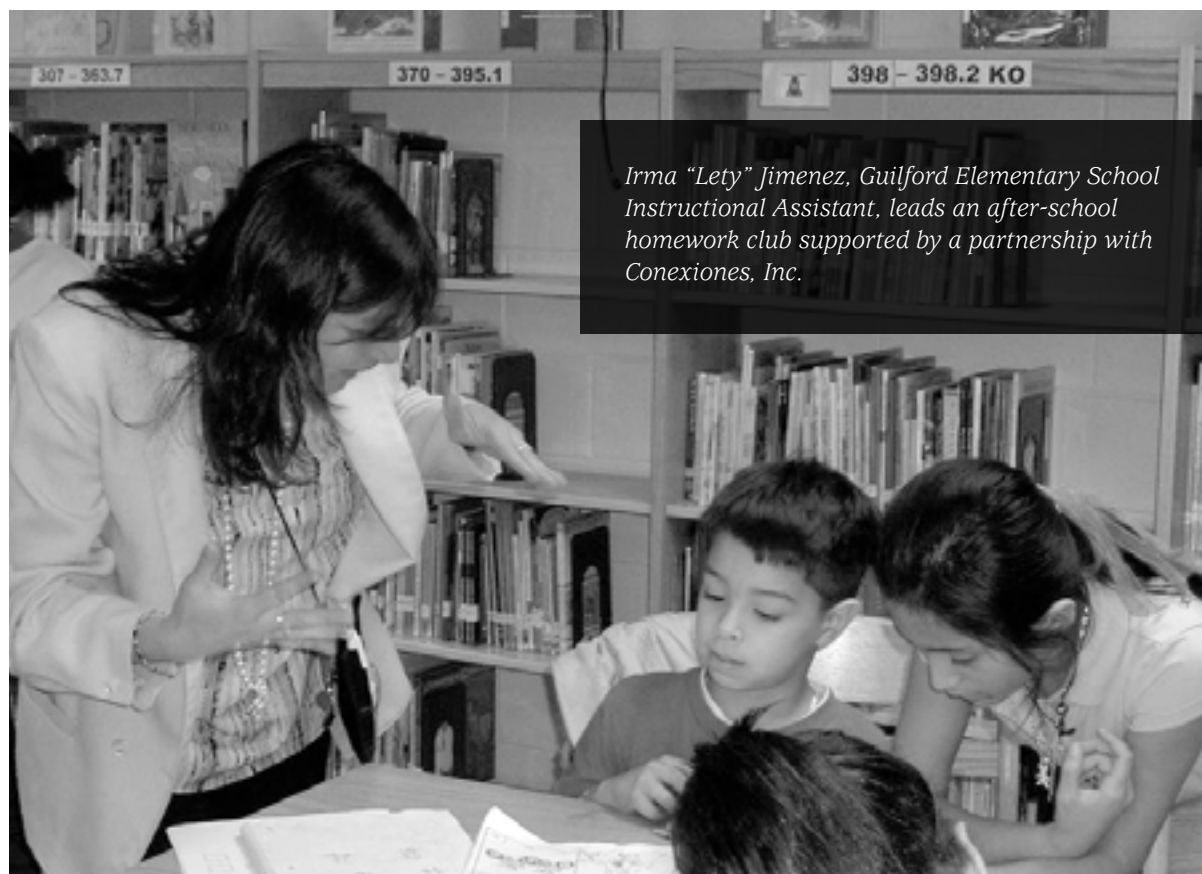
Since January, students at Guilford Elementary have been receiving extra academic support and encouragement at a biweekly after-school homework club, with Hispanic bilingual tutors provided by Conexiones. Volunteers from the organization also work with the school to offer evening information sessions in Spanish and English for Hispanic parents and guardians. The homework club's success at Guilford Elementary is serving as a model for other schools.

the encouragement of local parents, Dodson and two other teachers began a series of Saturday morning classes to reinforce classroom lessons. Originally, parents paid tuition; eventually sponsors, including the Columbia Foundation and the Bank of America, enabled the classes to be offered at no cost, thus opening the program to many children from low income families.

Currently, Helping Hands offers Saturday morning academic enrichment sessions throughout the fall and spring terms at Cradlerock School and at Running Brook, Swansfield, and Phelps Luck elementary schools. About sixty students participate at each school. Experienced, talented teachers are recruited, often from Howard County schools. Parents often volunteer in the classroom, and are invited to open houses and end-of-term celebrations.

Each student's improvement is carefully measured, with testing at the beginning and end of each term. The program's combination of extra practice, individual attention, and positive reinforcement pays off in higher reading levels and better grades. But as Pat Dodson observes, often the most significant improvement is in a child's attitude. "Kids enjoy school more. Attendance improves, and they participate a lot more in class."

After twenty years with Helping Hands, Pat Dodson still finds the same joy and satisfaction in each student's achievements. "There is nothing like going into a classroom on a Saturday, and seeing the smiles of excitement on the faces of the students. They respond so well to the extra attention and positive feedback." She credits Helping Hands's success to the support and involvement it enjoys at every level: from donors and parents, to school system staff and school custodians. Each school principal's enthusiasm and involvement are essential, she stresses, but

Allocate sufficient people, budget, time, and other resources to allow the partnership to succeed. Identify a "champion" within the organization to coordinate partnership activities and communications.
- 4 COMMUNICATION**
Ongoing, two-way communication is the cornerstone of a successful partnership.
- 5 EVALUATION AND EVOLUTION**
A good partnership is a dynamic relationship - adaptable to changing needs and circumstances. Plan to meet regularly to review the partnership's effectiveness, and revise it as needed. Establish criteria for success that are easy to measure.




