
PROGRAM MISSION



Curriculum Extension Units (CEUs)

- Interdisciplinary (primarily Science or Social Studies content)
- Advanced-level
- 2-3 per grade lasting approximately 9-12 weeks each (or 5-6 weeks if taught daily)
- All students reviewed as part of G/T
 Placement Process using multiple criteria.


GT Math
