The Maryland State Board of Education requires that each school system provide instruction about Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS). The Howard County Public School System will provide instruction in grades 4-12.

In Health Education, students receive instruction related to HIV/AIDS instruction in Grades 6, 8, and 9. HIVIAIDS education will stress the importance of good health habits such as abstinence from sexual intercourse and refraining from the use of IV drugs and sharing needles. Education about HIVIAIDS may also be included in special school programs such as the DisAbility Awareness Day and Wellness Days. You as a parent/guardian may request that your child be excluded from HIV/AIDS instruction and other activities that provide information about HIVIAIDS. Please carefully consider your decision before requesting exclusion. HIVIAIDS education is critical in preventing the spread of HIV/AIDS.

If you elect to request exclusion of HIV/AIDS instruction in Health Education, sign the statement below and return it to your child's school immediately.
