## Enrollment Requests



- The first enrollment request window will open February 1, 2023 and is limited to current HCPSS students only.
- Requests may be made by a parent, guardian, school counselor or achievement liaison.
- Requests are submitted online through the Synergy Parent Portal on the HCPSS Connect web page, www.hcpss.org/connect.
- Enrollment requests for BSAP and G/T programs are completed through a lottery process. Requests are NOT first-come, first-served. Families will receive an email when a student is enrolled in a course or added to the applicable course wait list.
- For Innovative Pathways High School enrollment requests, priority will be given to students by their current grade level within that window.

## ()Meals and Transportation



- Sites offer either a snack or breakfast/lunch at no cost
- BSAP, Innovative Pathways and Summer Math Scholars offer transportation for students via community bus stops; door-to-door service is not provided.
- Community bus stop locations are based on student enrollments.
